## Solid Waste Management and Composting in Azam Campus

The Management maintains clean and green campus. There is a provision of dustbins in the campus at strategic locations like outside the hostel, canteens etc. Sanibins are in placed as per the requirement. Adequate staff is also appointed for maintaining the cleanliness. The solid waste generated in the College and campus is collected and segregated. The biodegradable organic waste is processed for composting. Campus has its own Vermicomposting pits at various locations. Most of the waste from the garden is converted into compost and used as a fertilizer. The rest of the waste is disposed as per set norms. The composting pits are maintained by the Environmental Science Department of the Senior College along with the Gardner, Mr. Dilip and his staff under the guidance of Mrs. Jyoti Shah. Mrs. Shah is a well known environmentalist and a pioneer of 'Go Green Movement'. She personally visits and gives her suggestions. The waste is collected in the pits and allowed to compost. After three months, the compost becomes ready which is used as a fertilizer for the plants on the campus.
